The health and safety of our residents is our utmost priority; the Town Hall is opening for the Town Clerk's office starting Wednesday, May 13, 2020. The hours to the public will be Monday – Thursday 8AM – 2:30PM and Saturdays 8AM – 11:30am. The building will close half an hour early in order for the premises to be sanitized. The number of people allowed in the building at a time will be limited. You must wear a mask while on the premises and maintain social distancing whenever possible. The following services will be available for our residents again:

Dog licenses:

New license: please supply proof of rabies vaccinations & of spay/neuter and submit with payment - \$13 for intact dogs/\$5 for spayed or neutered dogs

Renewals: please supply license renewal paperwork with payment and proof of rabies vaccination if rabies information on form is expired or expiring within 30 days - \$13 for intact dogs/\$5 for spayed or neutered dogs

Transfer Station – please see Transfer Station UPDATE May 7, 2020 for details

Sewer Payments – please submit payments with the stub from the bottom of the bill. Please verify that you are using the correct account number off your bill in the memo section of your check.

Fishing License – may be purchased online at www.dec.ny.gov/permits/6091.html you are able to immediately print your fishing license on regular paper when purchased this way.

Marriage License – Darien residents looking for a marriage license should contact the Town Clerk at 585-547-2274 ext 1026 to schedule an appointment.

Accessible Parking Permits – please call the Town Clerk at 585-547-2274 ext. 1026

PLEASE NOTE – paperwork listed as needing to be submitted may be mailed via USPS or placed in the blue drop box outside the main office doors. The drobox is checked every day. You may also make payments online through the “How Do I? Pay Taxes and Clerk Fees Online”
