Supervisor Ferry gave updates on COVID-19. We have the cleaning company doing sanitizing once a week on top of the regular cleaning. At \$45/week, feel it is worth it. Had the clerk pick up the camera for live streaming at about \$70. For Planning Board meetings, a decision will be made a week prior to the meeting. Closed the Transfer Station for a minimum of 2 weeks. Discussion held on re-opening, consensus was to keep it closed; our employees health and safety is important. Requested to have Neil get a sign made for the gates. Board members need to look at their budgets over the next month and see where we can make adjustments; projecting a 25% decrease in revenues due to this. Money transferred to the Highway can not be touched though. The Blood Drive scheduled for Friday, May 1, 2020 is still going on. There is a vital need for blood, please make an appointment to donate blood – we will have the cleaners in just before and just after. The GCEDC has information for small businesses. It is likely that the assessments will stay where they are and won't increase town wide until at least next year. The Highway Department is working 40 hours a week; building is locked so only employees can get in, doing routine work.
